I am writing in reply to your request for details of numbers of heavy goods vehicles licensed to operate from Grove Lane, Elmswell, Suffolk.

All holders of a goods vehicle operator's licence must specify one or more operating centres where the vehicles are kept when not in use. Notification of an application to register a new operating centre, or to increase the number of vehicles authorised to operate from an existing centre, must be advertised in a local paper beforehand. You may be interested to know that notifications of new applications are also published in *Applications and Decisions*, copies of which are available free of charge on our website, www.vosa.gov.uk, at;

I have checked our computer records and can confirm that nine goods vehicle operators are currently authorised to operate a combined total of 72 goods vehicles from operating centres in Grove Lane, Elmswell IP30 9HN.

In May 2003, seven goods vehicle operators were authorized to operate from the same location. At that time, these operators had a combined total of 68 goods vehicles in their possession.
