FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

I refer to my letter of 5th June 2006. Please find below a synopsis relating to the Operator licences specified in your letter of 26th May 2006.

PH0005716 – Daish's Hotel was removed from this licence as an Operating Centre in October 2002. This was published in N&P 2202 dated 29th October 2002. The vehicle authorisation for the Operating Centre at Bredon Court Hotel was increased from 7 to 10, and this was published in N&P 2240 dated 13th April 2004 Devonshire Hotel was added as an operating centre in October 2005. This was published in N&P 2279 dated 11th October 2005

PH0006410 – Kenneth H Wilson – This licence lapsed when it was not renewed in February 2005. This was published in N&P 2266 on 12th April 2005.

PH1033761 – Daish's Coaches Ltd – This new application was published in N&P 2243 which was published on 25 May 2004. The licence came into operation on 23^d July 2004, and details of the grant of the licence were published in N&P 2248 on 3rd August 2004
