**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000**

I am writing to confirm that the Vehicle and Operator Services Agency (VOSA) has now completed its search for the information you requested on 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2006.

Passenger transport which is provided by various groups may be exempt from Operator Licencing requirements. Details of those groups who may operate in this way (which includes educational establishments) is given our publication "Passenger Transport in the Voluntary Sector" (PSV 385).
