



Who should attend

Those responsible for the maintenance of Heavy Goods Vehicles, Public Service Vehicles, light vehicles and motorcycles in relation to British or British Forces Germany (BFG) roadworthiness standards. Delegates must be briefed by their own organisation on what their objectives/purposes of attending. Delegates must be released from normal duties for the period of the course.

Benefits

Delegates will benefit from a greater understanding of minimum required roadworthiness standards and will learn a systematic approach to inspecting vehicles to maximise the chance of detecting defects.

10 Day inspection standards and procedures course

This course will cover a similar syllabus to the HGV and PSV Inspections Standards and Procedures courses (see pages 6 & 16), as well as an element of the MOT Light Vehicles and motorcycle courses (see page 29) and will include written and practical assessments for each delegate.

3 Day BFG inspection standards and procedures course

This course will take delegates through the Army quality control standards required for the BFG test (derived from British standards, applicable local regulations and STVO regulations) as well as providing a structured procedure for carrying out tests. At the end of the course, delegates will be formally assessed on their knowledge and competence.
