



MOT tester training



Who should attend

This is a 3 day mandatory course for prospective MOT Testers. It has been designed to develop the skills and knowledge necessary for those involved with the testing of vehicles in test classes III, IV, and VII. Existing MOT Testers may also benefit from this training.

Access

Each delegate must complete a VT78 form. Please contact 0117 954 3434 to request a VT78 form. Candidates must be a skilled mechanic with at least four years full time experience, hold a full valid driving licence for the class(s) of vehicle they wish to test, and be sponsored by an authorised MOT garage. Additionally candidates must have passed the Inspectorate's NTT(A) examination OR be an existing MOT tester OR possess one or more of the following vocational qualifications:

- a) National Craft Certificate in Vehicle Maintenance & Electronic Systems
- b) City & Guilds, Repair and Servicing of Road Vehicles (syllabus 381 or 383)
- c) BTEC Vehicle Engineering Studies (National Certificate)
- d) SCTVEC Vehicle Mechanics & Systems parts 1 to 3 (National Certificate)
- e) NVQ or SVQ in Vehicle Mechanical & Electrical Systems, Maintenance & Repair level 3

Students will be aware of the standards and procedures for carrying out an MOT inspection.
